

## Bible Reading from the Old Testament

Isiah 40. verses 12 to 17; 27 to end.

### God's People Are Comforted

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand and marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance? Who has directed the spirit of the LORD, or as his counsellor has instructed him? Whom did he consult for his enlightenment, and who taught him the path of justice? Who taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding? Even the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as dust on the scales; see, he takes up the isles like fine dust. Lebanon would not provide fuel enough, nor are its animals enough for a burnt-offering. All the nations are as nothing before him; they are accounted by him as less than nothing and emptiness.

Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel, 'My way is hidden from the Lord, and my right is disregarded by my God'? Have you not known? Have you not heard? 2 Corinthians 13: verses 11 to end.

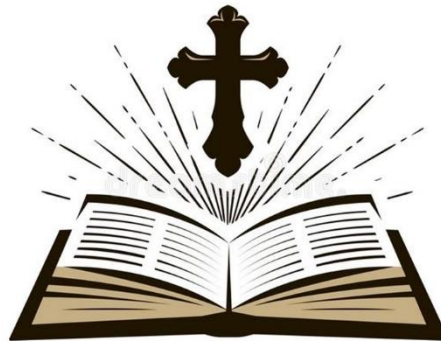
### Final Greetings and Benediction

### Stamping Out Cancer

Thank you to those who have used stamps for the Bone Cancer Research Trust. Bone cancer can be difficult to treat, and many patients require extensive surgery and aggressive chemotherapy. Recent research has shown promising results giving hope to patients and their families. One breakthrough in bone cancer research involves the use of immunotherapy. This works by harnessing the body's own immune system to attack cancer cells. Researchers have found that certain immune cells, called T cells, can be reprogrammed to target and kill cancer cells in bone tumours. This has led to the development of new immunotherapies that can specifically target cancer cells, while leaving healthy cells intact. Around 8,000,000,000 stamps are issued in the UK each year so we have a large target to aim at and I am looking forward to seeing my first King Charles III stamp 😊
